Eligible applicants must be from the Lehigh Valley /Phillipsburg Area. The student must be pursuing a post-secondary education degree at a two-year or four-year institution.

Applicants will be judged on their completed application, short essay, a letter of recommendation from a certified educator who has worked with the applicant in the past three years, and their artwork submission. In the past, students submitted artwork for the board to review. This year we have the opportunity to exhibit artwork at Easton's State Theater. This pop-up exhibition will take place

When composing the essay, reflect on volunteer experiences in the community, involvement in the arts or performance related extracurricular activities. Name the intended institution of study and choice of major if already considered.

All artworks should be labeled/packaged and made available for pick-up in the main office of the corresponding high school by 3/17/17. All artworks will be returned to the main offices of each high school by 5/1/17.

The application, essay and letter of recommendation should be received together, postmarked no later than 4/22/16 to be considered.
